This letter is in response of your denial of our "Application for Demolition and Construction Permits original date of 11/23/05, are hereby resubmitted on 01/02/06

All original 6 pages , that you flatly refused with a copy of your letter dated 06/10/04 that you hand delivered via your temporary code enforcer by the name of

Waldo Gilpatrick

In this letter you stated (copy attached for your reference) the following statements.

FR: Jeff Kobrock, City Manager

Upon the advice of City Solicitor Erik Stumpf, Esq. we will require payment of all outstanding balances due the City before issuing any type

permit/license/authorization to applicants. The majority of our residents make the effort to be current in all their obligations. In fairness to that majority of residents, we need to work with those who have, outstanding balances to clear those balances before issuing any type of City authorization.

Thank you for your assistance with this effort.

I submit to you the following

1. Flat out denial, you never processed our application in the first place
2. Your actions are highly unusual, there are no known instances of these types of actions, according to the attorneys I spoke with.
3. Your actions stem from **retribution** rather than any tax issues that you make claim to.
4. Land use ordinances are reasons for denial of these types of permits, not tax issues, these tax issues is something that is written by you expressly and not part of any town procedure. Such procedure as you express are not normal procedure and are in fact abnormal.

In fact the City of Gardiner in conjunction with your cooperation did in fact issue construction permits to start the project. In fact we have half of the project completed. In fact according to your letter dated 06/10/04 proofs it. This letter was in fact issued after we filed complaints against you and Chris Paszyc of misconduct and wrong doing to Orman Withcomb. A seven page letter documents the complaint, I have enclosed a copy for your reference. This is no ordinary letter, it details lying and recorded conversation of lying. The recordings are available to anyone on our website www.GardinerMaineProblems.com follow the link to Hud allegations. Yes Orman Withcomb did pronounce you innocent of these allegations by ignoring the allegations made against you, on December 14, 2005 I discovered City of Gardiner documents, that prove the allegations against you Jeff Kobrock and Chris Paszyc. This, I submit to you, is the reason for the **retribution. Look at the dates, permits were issued before and not after. As for the tax issue, we paid the City of Gardiner the following taxes, at or about \$1,600.00, in the year 2005, in the year 2004, in the year 2003. How many people do you know of that pay triple taxes? Our current taxes are only \$550.00, Why?, because when I complained to you about our taxes and showed you the photos you see on the internet, my property evaluation jumped from \$63,000.00 to \$83,000.00. McPheters and made you issue the permit.

Any illegal and or criminal actions on your part Jeff Kobrock or the City of Gardiner are not protected, this means you and or the city in conjunction with you can be sued and held libel.

In addition to this illegal action of plumbing permit denial, you or someone in your office sent the City of Gardiner Police to further harass and try to intimidate **me**.

I submit to you that your letter is so restrictive and so unreasonable, that it should be


struck down immediately, according to this letter we cannot register our vehicles.
